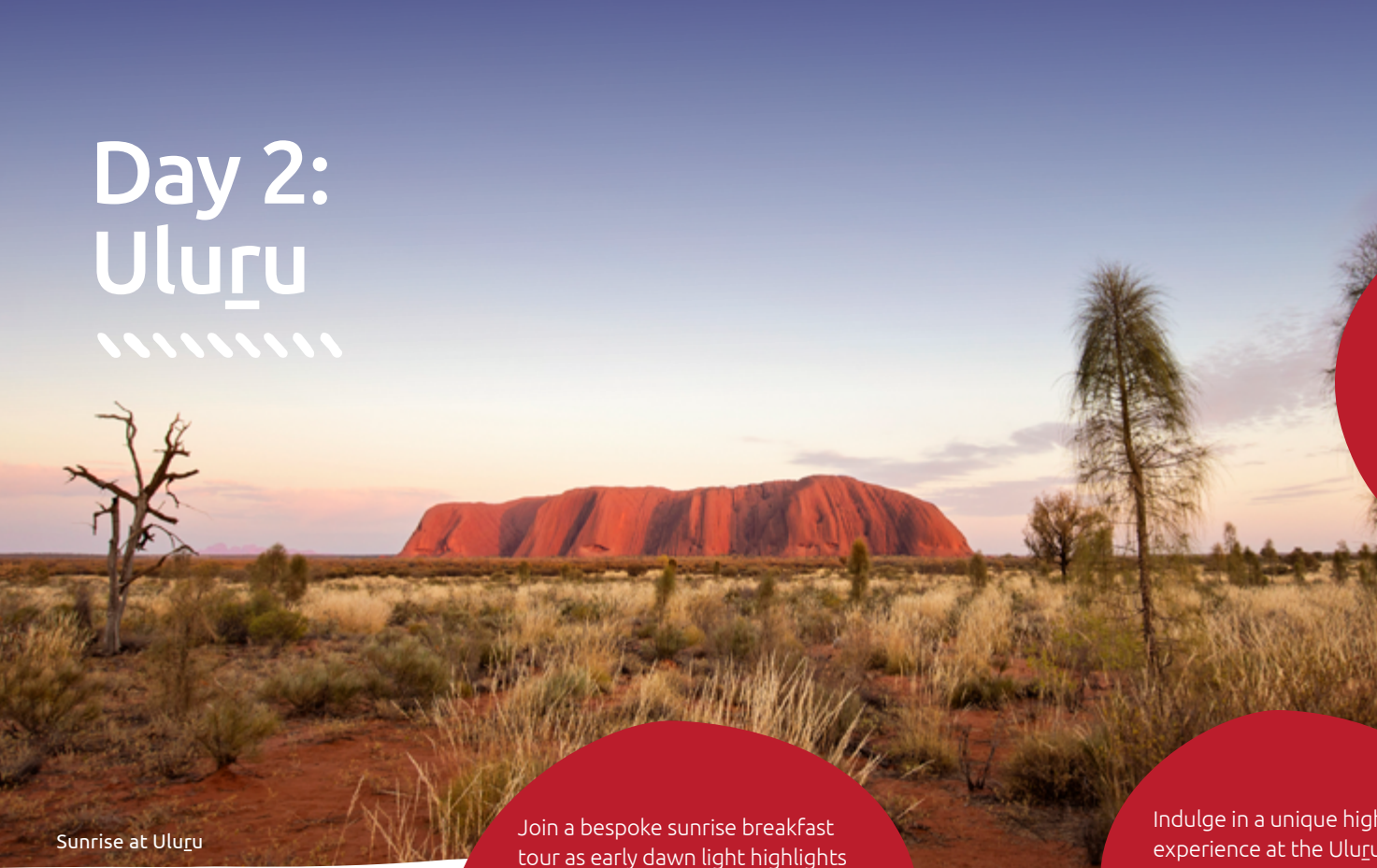


As custodians of the land, Anangu hold the Mala story from Kaltukatjara to Uluru.

Indulge in a unique high-tea experience at the Uluru Meeting Place and learn about the inspiring journey behind Winitjiri Wiru.

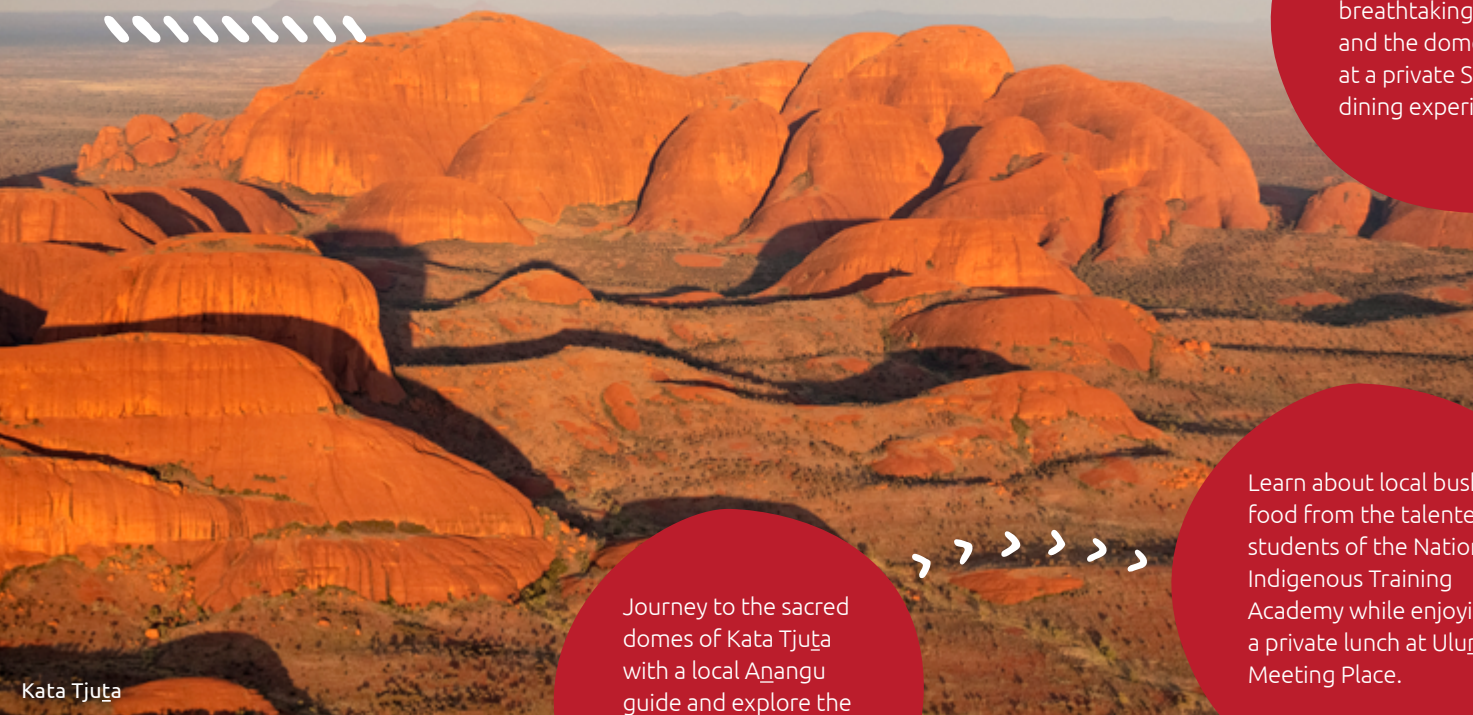
See the wonderful night sky like never before on a private star gazing tour. Learn the cultural significance of the constellations to local Aboriginal people.

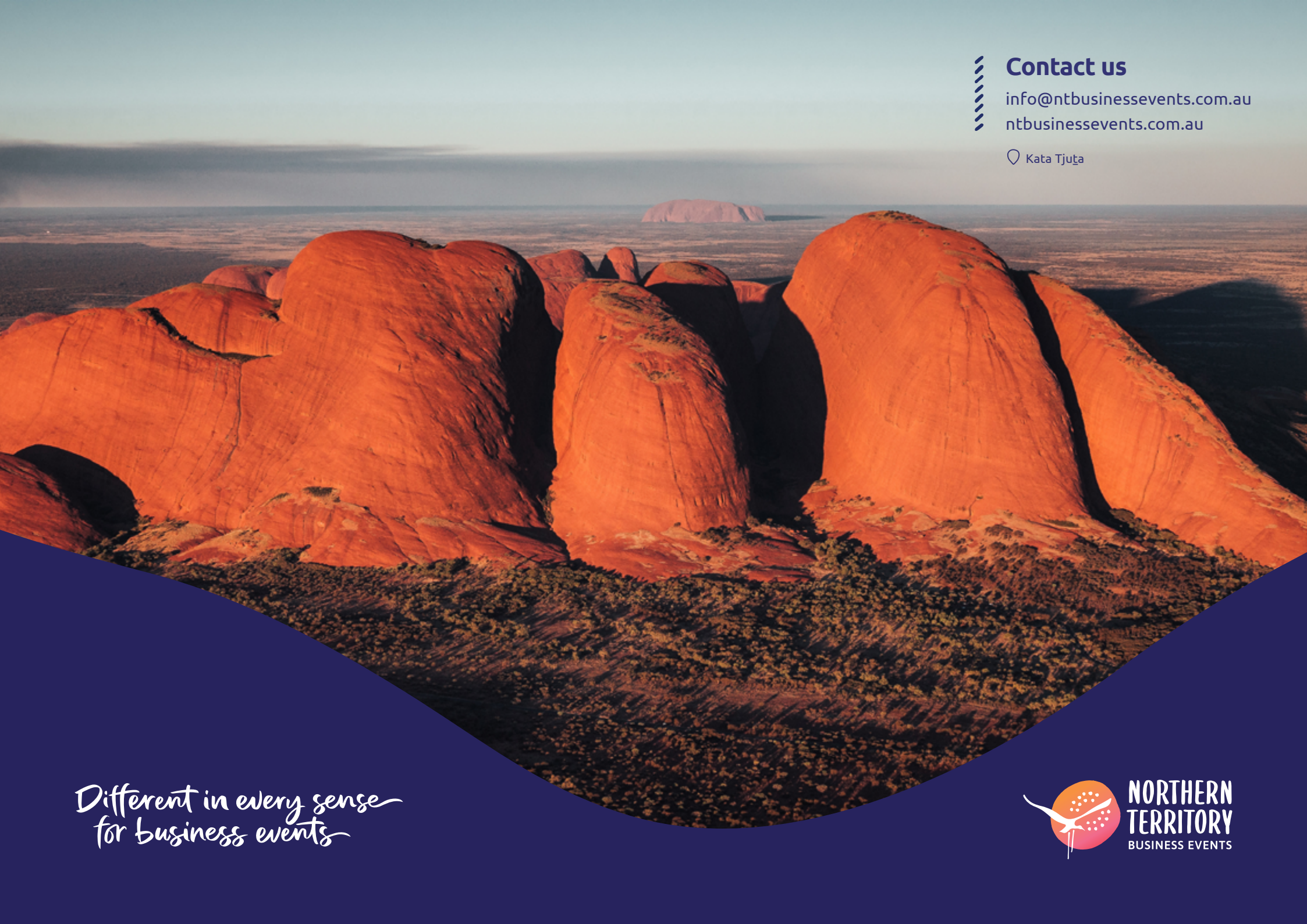
